Scoring Block Rubrics	
Cover page:	Four (4) points will be deducted if the cover page is absent. Two (2) points will be deducted if the cover page is incomplete.
Spelling and grammar	Three (3) points will be deducted for every spelling or grammar error. No more than six (6) points will be deducted.
References	Four (4) points will be deducted if references are omitted. Two points will be deducted if references are improperly formatted.

Essay format	An essay consists of a thesis paragraph, body paragraphs, and a concluding paragraph. The thesis paragraph summarizes the essay and introduces the ideas to be covered in more depth in the body paragraphs. Each paragraph in the body of your essay addresses a single topic. The final paragraph repeats the thesis emphasizing those points in your essay.
3 problems	Up to five (5) points will be awarded for each problem introduced. Points will be awarded for clarity and brevity. Points will be deducted for failing to address significant aspects of the problem. Points will be awarded for presenting a persuasive argument that the problem is a contemporary issue that relates to software or computing.
3 solutions	Up to five (5) points will be awarded for each solution that addresses one of the problems discussed above. Points will be awarded for clarity and brevity. Points will be deducted for failing to address significant aspects of the solution. Points will be awarded for presenting a persuasive argument that the solution is a contemporary issue that relates to software or computing.
