

**Programming Project:**

A maximum of thirty (30) points can be earned by completing a programming project.

Author identification on <i>all</i> source files	1
<b>Stapled</b> source listings and cover sheet (No paper clips, please)	1
Project structure and abstract data type implementation	6
Error free compilation (note 1)	6
Successful execution	15

Notes:

1. No points, *zero* (0), are given to any program containing compilation errors.
2. **Ten** (10) points are deducted from any project having source file names that differ from the specifications given in the project assignment.
3. Your source listings together with your cover sheet are a *request* to have your programming assignment graded. Your instructor compiles and tests the source in a separate directory when grading your assignment. You must not erase your source files before your assignment is graded and returned to you. Any adjustment in your score is based on the source in your student account.
4. Source for programming projects must reside in the root directory of the Department of Computer Science account given to you in this class.
